Project Title: Gray Lodge Water Supply Project (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2019-024-02-A4 (ITP))

Project Location: The Gray Lodge Wildlife Area Water Supply (Project) is located 65 miles north of Sacramento, in the eastern Sacramento Valley. The Project begins near the intersection of Highway 99, north of the City of Biggs, where it intersects with the main canal (Belding lateral) and continues southwest past the cities of Biggs and Gridley and terminates at the northern border of the Gray Lodge Wildlife Area.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) is approving an Amendment to the ITP that includes the following changes: First, this Amendment adds two new minor modifications to be constructed at the end of the Traynor and Schwind Laterals where they enter the Gray Lodge Wildlife Area. Second, this Amendment updates Figure 2 of the ITP which depicts the proposed timing of the work associated with Traynor and Schwind Laterals. In addition, it adds Figure 3B to the ITP and shows the location of the new minor modifications. Third, it identified additional permanent and temporary impacts to giant garter snake (GGS) habitat that will result from work added by Amendment No. 4. The new work will result in permanent impacts of 0.055 acre (0.038 acre of upland habitat and 0.017 of aquatic habitat) and temporary impacts of 0.015 acres of upland habitat. To date, the Permittee has purchased 14.36 GGS habitat credits from a CDFW-approved conservation bank to mitigate impacts on GGS habitat. As part of ITP compliance, habitat Impacts Verification are conducted annually to satisfy ITP Condition 8.11; through these Impacts Verifications, to date Project construction has been determined to be less impactful to GGS habitat than proposed, with a +0.763 GGS habitat acre/credit balance identified. A total of 0.21 GGS habitat acre/credit from the credit balance will be used to offset impacts associated with new work approved by Amendment No. 4.

The Project will result in the permanent loss of 2.825 acres of Giant garter snake (*Thamnophis gigas*) upland habitat and temporary loss of 4.22 acres of aquatic habitat and 17.067 acres of upland habitat, for a total of 21.287 acres. The Project is expected to result in the expansion of Covered Species aquatic habitat of 5.259 acres. The Project is expected to result in incidental take of giant garter snake which is designated as a threatened species under the California Endangered Species Act. The ITP referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of species listed under CESA that may occur as a result of Project implementation.
