<u>Project Description</u>: The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) adopted an Addendum to the previous Initial Study/Negative Declaration (IS/ND) and approved the renewal of an existing Hazardous Waste Facility Post-Closure Permit (PCP), pursuant to authority granted under California Health and Safety Code Chapter 6.5 and California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 4.5, Chapter 20.

The Post Closure Permit Renewal (Permit) is for Waste Management Unit (WMU) 17 at the Facility. WMU 17 is a closed and covered 4-acre area formerly used for oily waste storage. No physical changes to the site are proposed in this Permit. On July 30, 1998, the Department of Toxic Substances Control issued the initial Post Closure Permit for the Facility. The Permit outlines three primary functions: 1) maintenance of the closure cover, 2) environmental monitoring; and 3) maintenance of financial mechanisms to fund the post closure activities. This permit modification would not affect any aspect of the environment and requires no construction. All post closure activities will continue to be consistent with the previously approved Post Closure Permit. The renewal of an existing Hazardous Waste Facility PCP would not result in a significant impact on the environment.

As Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC approved the above-described project on November 19, 2021 and has made the following determinations:

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2. A Negative Declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of project approval.
- 4. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.
- 5. Findings were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
