Project Location (include county): The project is located on unnamed tributaries to Steelhead Creek, in the County of Placer, State of California; within Sections 9 and 10 of Township 10N, Range 5E; of the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 'Rio Linda' 7.5-minute topographic quadrangle, California; approximately centered on Latitude 38.740761°N, Longitude -121.433684°W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0382-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Placer Vineyards Central Group, LLC (Permittee) as represented by Rick Langdon.

The project is a component of the Placer Vineyards Specific Plan (PVSP), a 5,230-acre specific plan project, which includes on- and offsite infrastructure elements. The Segment E Project is a component of the Placer Vineyards Specific Plan (PVSP), a 5,230-acre specific plan project, which includes on- and offsite infrastructure elements. The 50.53-acre Segment E Project includes onsite infrastructure elements that are required for the development of the PVSP. Construction staging areas and access ways will be located in upland areas at least 20 feet from aquatic features. Two interim culverts will be placed side by side in the southwestern portion of the Segment C Project area. Approximately 44.72 acres of vernal pool grassland will be graded and restored (contoured) including preliminary grading for two water quality basins, as well as the construction of seasonal/perennial wetlands and a low flow channel.
