Project Title: Placer Vineyards Segment A Phase 1.2 (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0179-R2).

Project Location (include county): The project is located on unnamed tributaries to Steelhead Creek, in the County of Placer, State of California; within Sections 4, 5, and 8 of Township 10N, Range 5E, and Sections 31 and 32 of Township 11N, Range 5E; of the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 'Rio Linda' and Pleasant Grove 7.5-minute topographic quadrangles, respectively, California; approximately centered on Latitude 38.741182°N, Longitude -121.461851°W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0179-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Lennar Winncrest, LLC (Permittee) as represented by Larry Gualco.

The project is a component of the Placer Vineyards Specific Plan (PVSP), a 5,230-acre specific plan project, which includes onsite and offsite infrastructure elements. The 36.44-acre Segment A Phase 1.2 Project includes infrastructure elements that are required for the first phase of development for Property 19 (Segment Q Phase 1.1; Notification to be submitted separately) within the PVSP. The activities proposed within the Segment A Phase 1.2 area for which immediate authorization is sought by this Notification are limited to the following activities: expansion of Baseline Road, construction of a portion of future Dyer Lane, and construction of a portion of future 'A' Street. In the northwestern portion of the Segment A Phase 1.2 Project area approximately 3,175 linear feet of the southern extent of the existing two-lane Baseline Road will be expanded. Approximately 3,770 linear feet of future Dyer Lane will be constructed within the Project area.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
