Project Location: The Project will occur north of the existing State Route 46, approximately 1 mile east of the

community of Cholame in San Luis Obispo County.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS SLO-19001-R4, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Project Applicant, California Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

The Project involves the construction of two new double bridges, north of the existing SR46 alignment and the replacement of an existing culvert at Post Mile 57.8. The Project also involves the removal of two existing culvert systems at Post Mile 55.06 and Post Mile 56.04, and restoration of the streams.
