<p>Project Description:</p> <p>On September 10, 2007, the Coachella Valley Association of Governments certified the Final Environmental Impact Report (“EIR”), adopted Findings of Fact, and approved the Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan/Natural Communities Conservation Plan (“Project”). The EIR evaluated potential environmental impacts that could occur as a result of implementing the Project and/or alternatives and provided applicable mitigation to reduce the intensity of potential environmental impacts.</p> <p>On November 9, 2023, CVCC adopted a minor amendment to the Project, which serves to incorporate the results of a land exchange between the Agua Caliente Band of Mission Indians and the Bureau of Land Management into the Conservation Objectives and Conservation Areas designated by the Project. The amendment is a prescribed action under the Project whose environmental impacts were assessed in the previously certified EIR. Pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21166 and State CEQA Guidelines section 15162, approval of the minor amendment will result in no new or more severe impacts requiring additional environmental review of the approval action.</p>

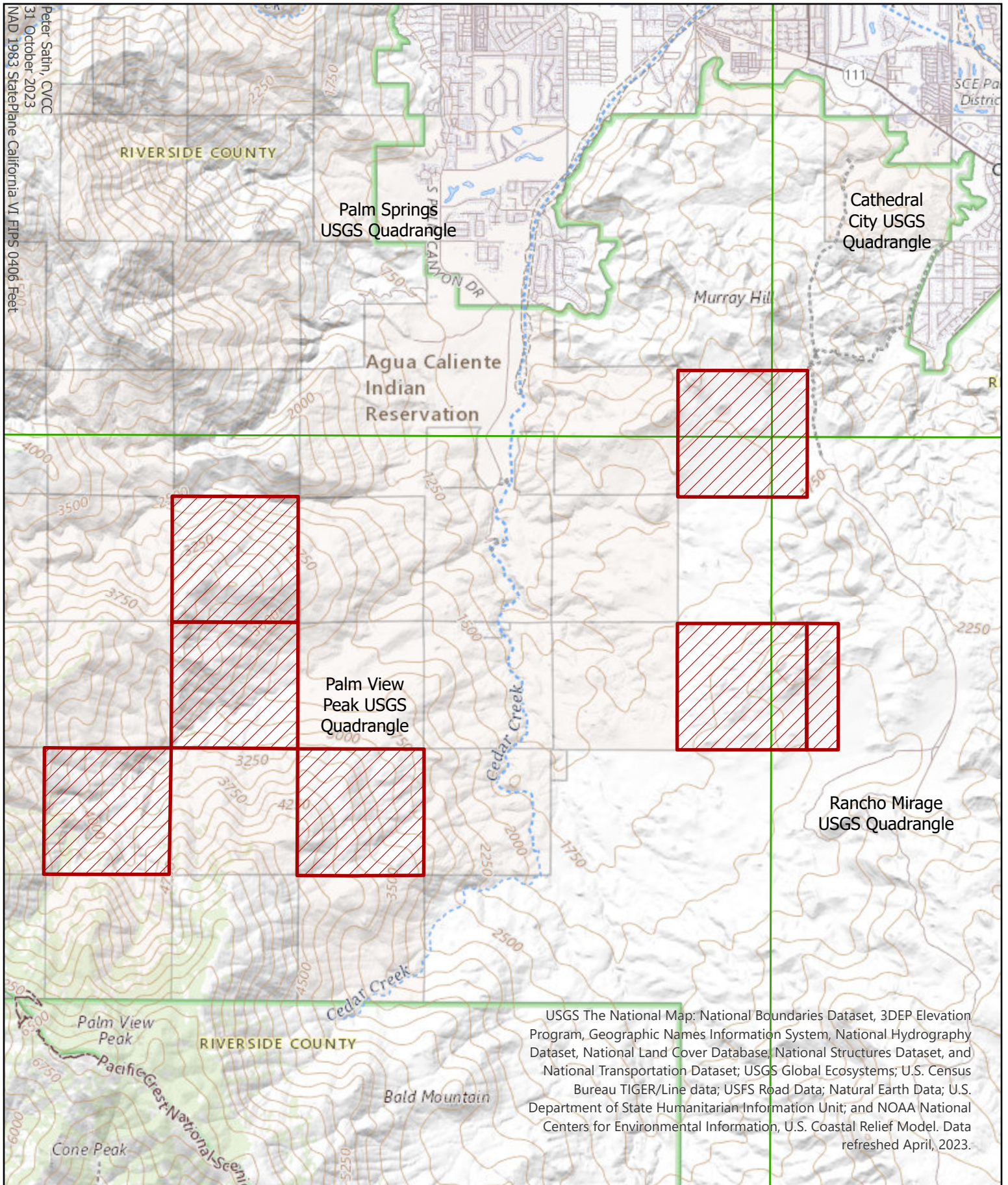
