Project Title: State Route 71 Widening Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration, Notification No. 1600-2019-0089-R5)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Chino Creek, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California on State Route 71 (SR-71) between Interstate 10 and SR-60 within the City of Pomona.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0089-R5, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation, District 7, as represented by Paul Caron. The project will widen SR-71 to a standard 8-lane freeway, including three general purpose lanes and one HOV lane in each direction from I-10 to the Los Angeles/San Bernardino County Line.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on _____ and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
