Project Title: Upper Bohn Reservoir Enlargement (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0250-R3)

Project Location: Upper Bohn Reservoir at unnamed creek and Routan Creek in the Counties of Napa and Lake, State of California

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0250-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code, to the project Applicant, Dave Jordan.

The project is limited to enlarging the north and south dams on Upper Bohn Reservoir to increase the reservoir's storage capacity by 1,000 acre feet, extending and modifying the flood protection sill wall, and extending the outflow pipes below each dam. Permittee will continue to operate the north and south dams, which were constructed in 1965.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on May 3, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were / were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
