Project Title: Cowell Ranch Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-CCA-30671-R3)

Project Location (Contra Costa County): The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Kellogg Creek, in the County of Contra Costa, State of California; approximate mid-point Latitude 37.890866, Longitude -121.714874; Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 007-380-002-0 and 007-380-003-0.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-CCA-30671-R3), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to project Applicant Brentwood Commercial Partners LLC, as represented by Earl Callison.

The project will support the overall Cowell Ranch Development Project and will involve the installation of an approximately 110-foot-long, 64-foot-wide bottomless arched culvert bridge for channel crossing and site access, three stormwater outfall structures with rock slope protection dissipaters, and stormwater pipes. No trees will be impacted. Fill material removed from the channel will be managed where it cannot be redeposited into the channel.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on June 7, 2023, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

- 1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
- 2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
- 3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
