**Project Title:** Teichert Quarry (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0010-R2)

**Project Location:** The Project is located at unnamed tributaries to Canyon Creek and Coyote Creek, in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38° 36' N, Longitude 121° 7' W, Sections 36, 20, 29, 30, 31, 32, Township 9N, Ranges 7E and 8E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Map Buffalo Creek and Folsom SE, Assessor's Parcel Numbers 072-0110-051, 072-0110-053, 072-0110-060, 072-0110-061, 072-0110-062, 072-0110-063, portions of 072-0110-005, 072-0110-059, 072-0110-066, 072-0110-067, 072-0110-068, 072-0110-069 and 072-0110-070, and portions of 072-0060-070 and 072-0060-071.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0010-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project applicant, Teichert Aggregates, as represented by Barry Baba.

The project is limited to the construction of a new mining facility on 384-acres within the 580-acre site. The mining operation will result in the extraction, transportation and refinement of hard rock material.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
