Project Title: Tentative Tract Map 16767 (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2021-056-06 (ITP))

Project Location (include county): The project is located on a 9.98-acre area (Assessor's Parcel Numbers 405-521-35, 36, and 37) within the City of Hesperia, San Bernardino County. The project is located approximately 0.48 miles west of the California Aqueduct at approximately 34.414482°, -117.367362°. The project site is bounded by Hollister St. to the north and Fuente Ave.to the east.

Project Description: This proposed project involves the development of the project area into a tentative tract map consisting of 52 single family residential units and a retention basin.

The Project will result in impacts to 7.10 acres of western Joshua tree (*Yucca brevifolia*) habitat; the Project will permanently remove 7.10 acres of western Joshua tree habitat. The project is expected to result in incidental take of western Joshua tree, which is designated as a candidate threatened species under the California Endangered Species Act. The ITP referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of species listed under CESA that may occur as a result of Project implementation.
