- 4. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was previously-adopted for the Revised Platinum Triangle Expansion Project.
- 5. Based upon the evidence submitted and as demonstrated by the analysis included in the environmental checklist prepared for the A-Town development Area G, none of the conditions described in Sections 15162 or 15163 of the State CEQA Guidelines calling for the preparation of a subsequent or supplemental EIR or negative declaration have occurred; specifically:
  - a. The A-Town Development Area E Project does not represent a substantive change in the Revised Platinum Triangle Expansion Project that would require major revisions of the CEQA Documents because of new significant environmental effects or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant effects;
  - b. There have not been any substantial changes with respect to the circumstances under which the A-Town Development Area E Project would be undertaken that require major revisions of the CEQA Documents due to the involvement of new significant environmental effects or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant effects; and
  - c. There is no new information of substantial importance, which was not known and could not have been known with the exercise of reasonable diligence at the time EIR No. 339 was certified as complete or the other CEQA Documents were adopted, that shows any of the following: (a) the A-Town Development Area E Project will have one or more significant effects not discussed in EIR No. 339 or the other CEQA Documents; (b) significant effects previously examined will be substantially more severe than shown in EIR No. 339 or the other CEQA Documents; (c) mitigation measures or alternatives previously found not to be feasible would, in fact, be feasible and would substantially reduce one or more significant effects of the A-Town Development Area E Project, but the Owner declines to adopt the mitigation measure or alternative; or (d) mitigation measures or alternatives which are considerably different from those analyzed in EIR No. 339 would substantially reduce one or more significant effects on the environment, but the Owner decline to adopt the mitigation measure or alternative.



Brief Project Description: A General Plan Amendment, amendments to The Platinum Triangle Mixed Use (PTMU) Overlay Zone and Zoning reclassifications have been proposed by the City to expand the boundaries of the PTMU Overlay Zone and increase the permitted residential, office, commercial and institutional development intensities within the Platinum Triangle. Approval of the proposed amendments would result in maximum development intensities of 18,900 dwelling units 14,340,522 square feet of office uses 4,909,682 square feet of commercial uses, and 1,500,000 square feet of institutional uses within the Platinum Irlangle. There is no proposed development intensity increase for properties within the IRlatinum Triangle that are outside of the expanded PTMU Overlay Zone.
