Project Location (include county): The project is located at Ingram Slough and unnamed tributaries to Ingram Slough and Orchard Creek, in the County of Placer, State of California; Latitude 38.863202, Longitude -121.327499 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees). The approximately 516-acre project site is located southwest of the City of Lincoln and west of Highway 65.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-27000-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Lincoln Land Holdings, LLC.

The approximately 516-acre project is a proposed mixed-use development within the City of Lincoln. Construction of the project includes cut and fill associated with grading activities, construction of five (5) vehicle and pedestrian bridges, and the construction of several water quality features to treat stormwater from the development and discharge into open space corridors. The project will result in permanent impacts to 8.66 acres of aquatic habitat including 0.08 acre of vernal pool, 4.03 acres of seasonal wetlands, 1.34 acres of drainage swale wetlands, 1.13 acres of Ingram Slough, and 2.08 acres of wetlands associated with an abandoned farm pond and ditches.
