Project Title: Glenborough at Easton & Easton Place (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2015-0207-R2

**Project Location:** The project is located off Aerojet Road and U.S 50, in between the cities of Rancho Cordova and Folsom, in unincorporated Sacramento County. 38°27' 45" North, 121°10' 45" West.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has extended Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2015-0207-R2 pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Easton Development Company, LLC.

The overall Project consists of two communities: Glenborough at Easton and Easton Place. Glenborough at Easton is a ±1,208-acre community with 3,239 dwelling units that includes residential, commercial mixed use, commercial, office, open space, park, and quasi-public uses. Easton Place is a ±183-acre transit-oriented village with approximately 3.5 million square feet of commercial space, and an additional 1,644 dwelling units. Together, the Glenborough at Easton and Easton Place communities include 4,833 dwelling units. In addition to the development areas of the Project, a network of approximately 10 miles of bicycle and pedestrian trails are proposed. The trails will connect the villages to commercial and transit areas, as well as the numerous parks and Alder Creek corridor.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, extended the above Streambed Alteration Agreement project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
