Project Location/City/County: The project is located where Norte Dame Blvd approaches Little Chico Creek, along the eastern limits of the City of Chico in Butte County.

Project Description: Approval of Permit No. 19617, under California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To authorize a 12-inch diameter ductile iron pipe water main extension under the low water channel of Little Chico Creek constructed under emergency authorization EM2022102.
