**Project Description:** The Upper San Leandro Water Treatment Plant Reliability Improvements Project (Project) is one of many projects in the certified WTTIP EIR and includes ozone system upgrades, a new filter-to-waste equalization basin, and a new filter-to-waste pumping plant. During the detailed design, some changes to the original Project were identified. These Project changes include upgrades to the raw water control valve, flocculation system, sedimentation basin, washwater reclaim and solids handling system, chlorine contact basin, clearwell, and miscellaneous electrical, structural, civil, and security improvements

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, EBMUD completed an Addendum to the WTTIP EIR to address environmental impacts from the design changes. An evaluation was conducted and it was determined that the changes do not result in new significant impacts or cause an increase in the severity of previously identified impacts as presented in the certified WTTIP EIR. EBMUD will implement the same mitigation measures for the design changes that are presented in the WTTIP EIR. No further environmental documentation is required.

## Upper San Leandro Water Treatment Plant Project Location Map

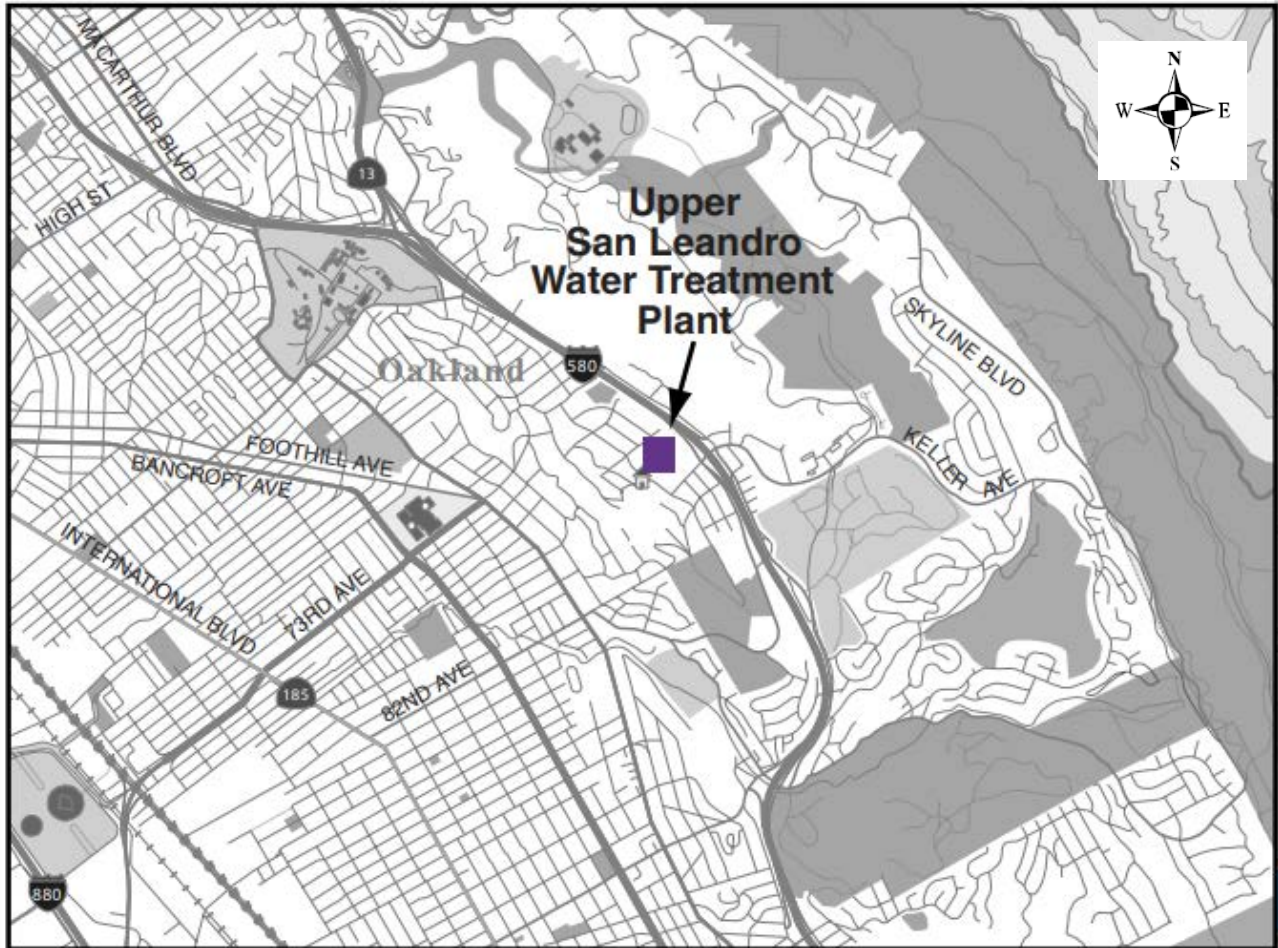

**Project Description:**

The Water Treatment and Transmission Improvements Program (WTTIP) includes new facilities and upgrades to existing facilities in Lafayette, Moraga, Oakland, Walnut Creek, and unincorporated Contra Costa County. The facilities include upgrades at five existing water treatment plants, 17 distribution system projects, and a reclaimed water pipeline. The projects are driven by a variety of overlapping needs including: meeting regulatory standards related to water quality, complying with permit conditions, addressing treated water stability issues, meeting existing and future water demands, improving aging infrastructure and the technology, and correcting existing hydraulic/operational constraints. The communities that would benefit from the program differ depending on the need being addressed and the facility being improved. The five water treatment plants are Lafayette Water Treatment Plant (WTP), Orinda WTP, Walnut Creek WTP, Sbrante WTP, and Upper San Leandro WTP. The 17 distribution system projects are: 1) Happy Valley Pumping Plant at the Alternative Site; 2) Happy Valley Inlet/Outlet Pipeline; 3) Ardith Reservoir; 4) Donald Pumping Plant; 5) Sunnyside Pumping Plant; 6) Glen Pipeline and Glen Reservoir Decommissioning; 7) Highland Reservoir Site as revised; 8) Highland Inlet/Outlet Pipeline; 9) Moraga Road Pipeline; 10) Moraga Reservoir; 11) Fay Hill Reservoir; 12) Fay Hill Pumping Plant; 13) Fay Hill Pipeline; 14) Tice Pumping Plant; 15) Tice Inlet/Outlet Pipeline; 16) Withers Pumping Plant; and 17) Leland Isolation Pipeline and Bypass Values. Project locations are listed on Table 1 attached.
