Project Title: Aviano Development Project [California Endangered Species Act (CESA) Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2013-019-03 Minor Amendment No. 1 (ITP)]

Project Location: The project is located at the terminus of Hillcrest Avenue within the City of Antioch, Contra Costa County and is located approximately 0.5 miles east of Deer Valley Road at approximately latitude 37.9517, longitude -121.7645. The project site is bounded by existing residential development to the north, Sand Creek to the south, and agricultural fields and the Dozier Libby High School to the west.

Project Description: The project consists of a Minor Amendment to the original project that includes addition of permanent fencing construction and a reduction in frequency of compliance monitoring by a Designated Biologist.
