**Project Location:** The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Laguna Creek in the City of Rancho Cordova, in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.538269, Longitude -121.202261 in Section 22, Township 08, Range 7E, Assessor's Parcel Number 067-0100-015-0000 located approximately 1.25 miles south of the intersection of Grant Line Road and Douglas Road.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-19751-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, AKT Investments, LLC as represented by Angelo Christie.
