Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-SDO-31328-R5), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, O'Side Partnership, LLC. The project consists of grading and filling the on-site channel to accommodate construction of a mixed-use resort with shopping, retail, commercial, and recreational opportunities interspersed with residential and open space uses.
