**Project Location (include county):** The project is located within Anderson Reservoir and the unlined spillways of Anderson Dam in the City of Morgan Hill, County of Santa Clara.


**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2014-0144-R3, Amendment No. 6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Vincent Gin/Santa Clara Valley Water District.

Phase 6 project activities include 8 test strips and 13 borings in the unlined spillway in order to collect additional geological and geotechnical data to supplement the design of the Anderson Dam Seismic Retrofit Project.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on May 19, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project  will /  will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
