Project Location (include county): The project is located at Zayante Creek, a tributary to the San Lorenzo River, in the County of Santa Cruz, State of California; Latitude 37° 3' 5.2" N, Longitude 122° 3' 49.2" W Degrees Minutes Seconds; Section 22, Township 10S, Range 2W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Felton; 6496 East Zayante Road, Felton, CA 95018; Assessor's Parcel Number 066-081-01.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0027-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Mount Hermon Association as represented by Dale Pollock.

The project will operate a seasonal flashboard dam, seasonal juvenile fish ladder, and attendant facilities in Zayante Creek, just upstream of the confluence with Bean Creek and near the community of Mount Hermon in Santa Cruz County. The impoundment will be used for boating and canoeing activities only during the summer months, and not for recreational swimming.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 09/10/2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
