Project Location (include county): The project is located at the intersection of State Route 60 and Moreno Beach Drive, in the City of Moreno Valley, California; Latitude 33.946459°, Longitude -117. 117.175510°. The streambed alteration/construction is within an unnamed tributary which ultimately drains to the Santa Ana River.		
Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0104-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Moreno Valley, as represented by Margery Lazarus.		
The project proposes the construction of a new drainage system along Ironwood Avenue (Line K-1) that directs a portion of the storm drain flows from the existing system at Moreno Beach Drive to the "Nason Basin" located at the northeast corner of the SR-60/Nason Street interchange. It is expected that construction of the Line K-1 diversion will allow lower flows (up to a maximum of 365 cubic feet per second) to continue to run through the existing drainage. High flows will be diverted to the Nason Basin.
