Applicant has requested to Amend Conditional Use Permit #07-0027 for the Allied Imperial Landfill to allow for Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) to be deposited at the landfill that originates from outside of Imperial County. The proposed CUP Amendment would allow up to 1,200 tons per day from locations in San Diego, Los Angeles, San Bernardino and Riverside counties (outside of Imperial County). The total tons per day for all waste would not exceed the current maximum tons as per contained in Condition 1.1.1 of CUP #07-0027 or the Final EIR for CUP #07-0027 (SCH No. 2007121049), nor would it exceed the maximum of 1,700 tons per day as allowed through the approved Solid Waste Facility Permit 13-AA-0019.
