Project Title: Federico Westpark (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0039-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located within Curry Creek, in the northern portion of the Sierra Vista Specific Plan; in the City of Roseville, County of Placer, State of California; Latitude 38.765842°, Longitude -121.384185°; in Sections 23, 35, and 36, Township 11 North, Range 5 East of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, USGS 7.5' quad 'Pleasant Grove'.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has amended Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0039-R2, pursuant to section 1602.

The amendment includes a modification to Sub-Project 6 as described in the Agreement to include the construction of a bio-retention water quality basin and a stormwater outfall.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
