PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Bass Lake Water Company (BLWC) proposes to construct a modern microfiltration treatment plant at the northwest corner of Bass Lake adjacent to Willow Creek and decommission the existing treatment facility.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The SWRCB Adopted and Considered the Addendum to the IS/MND on 12/18/2018 and approved the project described above on 7/31/2019. The BLWC will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is serving as lead agency for California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as the Project applicant is a non-governmental agency (CEQA Guidelines 15051). Additionally, the State Water Board is providing funding for the Project through the Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program (Public Resources Code 21102). The State Water Board has made the CEQA following determinations:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. An Addendum to the 2008 Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) was prepared for this Project pursuant to the provision of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures will be made a condition in the issuance of the funding agreement.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted for this project.
5. Determinations were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
6. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.

This is to certify the CEQA Addendum, IS/MND, MMRP, and other associated CEQA documents for the Project are available to the General Public at the State Water Board's office.

The Department of Fish and Wildlife (DFW) filing fees were paid in 2008 when the initial CEQA IS/MND was adopted.
