Project Title: Geysers Geothermal Project (Wildhorse Development Project and Buckeye Development Project)

Proponent: CPN Wild Horse Geothermal, LLC

Project Location: Geysers theothermal field, Sonoma County; APNs 117-210-010 (Parcel 1) and 117-220-007 (Parcel 2).

Project Description: Authorize the amendment for extension of the state geothermal resources lease no. PRC 8844.2 to provide for the drilling of geothermal wells in the Geysers Geothermal Field. The State Lands Commission action is an amendment of a 10-year Geothermal Resources Lease to extend the drilling term on Parcel 2 through August 31, 2029.

This is to advise that the Lead Agency Responsible Agency, has approved the above described project on August 23, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was adopted for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.

The lead agency for the project, Sonoma County, adopted the Mitigated Negative Declarations (MNDs) (SCH#s 2009042009 and 2009042013) and Mitigation Monitoring Programs associated with each MND on June 12, 2009, and June 15, 2009, respectively. The California State Lands Commission has considered the MNDs as prepared for this project by Sonoma County.
