Project Title: Highway 101 Carpinteria to Santa Barbara (Segment 4A – Carpinteria) (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0116-R5)

Project Location (include county): The project is located within the City of Carpinteria between Post Mile (PM) 1.4 and PM 4.6., in the County of Santa Barbara. The project will have effects to 10 locations including Franklin Creek, Santa Monica Creek, and ephemeral or intermittent tributaries.
