Project Title: Cold Stream Road-Donner Creek Structure Replacement Project, C1609 (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0344-R2)

Project Location (include county): Cold Stream Road south of Interstate 80, Truckee, CA. The culvert is the Donner Creek Crossing of Cold Stream Road.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0344-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Town of Truckee.

The Project will replace the existing corrugated metal pipe culvert with an open bottom precast concrete arched culvert and wing walls.
