Project Title: Cameron Ridge Wind Energy Project (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit (ITP) No. 2081-2011-031-04, Minor Amendment No. 6

Project Location: The Project is located between the cities of Tehachapi and Mojave, in the vicinity of Oak Creek and Tehachapi-Willow Springs Road, within Kern County, California.

Project Description: The Project involves the construction and operation of 26 wind turbines and associated infrastructure on approximately 1,350 acres. This proposed Project involves a minor amendment to the ITP referenced above to extend the expiration date of the ITP and the deadline to permanently protect the Habitat Management (HM) Lands by 3 years, from January 1, 2017 to January 1, 2020.

The ITP as amended authorizes take of Bakersfield cactus (*Opuntia basilarus* var. *treleasei*), a species designated as endangered under CESA. The ITP and Minor Amendments No. 1, No. 2, No. 3, No. 4, No. 5 and No 6 (ITP, as amended) as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of species listed under CESA that may occur as a result of Project implementation. CDFW issued the ITP, as amended, as a responsible agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), relying on mitigated negative declarations prepared for the Project as approved by the lead agency, Kern County.
