Project Title: Cordova Hills Master Plan Project – Phase 1A (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2015-0110-0002-R2).

Project Location: The Cordova Hills Master Plan Project (CHMP) is located in unincorporated eastern Sacramento County. The site is bordered to the west by Grant Line Road and Glory Lane to the north. The eastern and southern boundaries are not marked by physical features such as roads. Generally, the site is north of Kiefer Road and west of the Carson Creek drainage. CHMP site corresponds to portions of Sections 13, 14, 18, 23 & 24, Township 8 North, and Range 7 East and 8 East (MDBM) of the "Buffalo Creek, California" U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute quadrangle maps. The approximate center of the project is located at 38° 32' 37" North and 121° 9' 47" West within the Lower Sacramento and Upper Cosumnes Watersheds (#18020163 and #18040013, respectively, USGS 1978).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2015-0110-0002-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Permittee, Cordova Hills, LLC, as represented by Corey Harpole.

Cordova Hills Master Plan Project – Phase 1A includes activities for five projects as defined in the Master Streambed Alteration Agreement: 3 areas of site preparation/grading and addition of fill and installation of two drainage culverts in the 39-acre site.
