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NOTICE OF INTENT

Notice of Intent to Adopt a Supplemental Mitigated Negative Declaration

To: Interested Individuals, Reviewing Agencies, County Clerk of San Mateo County

Subject: Notice of Intent to Adopt a Supplemental Mitigated Negative Declaration (SMND) in

compliance with Section 21092.3 of the Public Resources Code.

This notice is to advise that the **City of East Palo Alto, as the Lead Agency, under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA),** has completed and intends to adopt a **Supplemental Mitigated Negative Declaration (SMND)** to supplement the previously prepared *Phoenix Academy Initial Study/MND* (State Clearinghouse No. 2010062078) adopted in August 2010. The SMND for the project has been prepared because there is new information of substantial importance — and/or significant changes in the project or existing environmental conditions - that require further evaluation. The proposed changes to the approved project are identified below.

Project Location and Current Use: The project is located on two parcels (APN 063-341-130 and 063-341-150), at the physical address of 1039 and 1063 Garden Street, approximately mid-block between Clarke Avenue and Pulgas Avenue. The site was previously approved and constructed for a charter school serving up to 411 students from grades 6-12.

Project Title: KIPP Esperanza High School Project

Project Description: The project sponsor, KIPP Bay Area Public Schools, is proposing to operate a public charter high school (KIPP Esperanza High School) to ultimately serve up to 650 students in grades 9-12. The school is planning to open with 180 students and could expand enrollment up to 650 over a four-year period, with 16 full time employees at opening and up to 44 at full enrollment. Four additional classrooms (approximately 4,000 square feet) are proposed to be added to accommodate the additional student population.

With the project, the campus would continue to operate as a public educational facility. However, compared to the existing school campus and permitted operations, the requested CUP would result in the following changes to the existing condition and campus plan:

- Interim (Phase 1) use of the existing East Parking as an outdoor all-weather basketball court.
- Ultimate (Phase 2) construction of four new classrooms (including two restrooms and outdoor gathering space) to replace the interim basketball court use. New building area would total 4,000 square feet, or a less than 10 percent increase over existing 38,400 square feet.
- Change in total parking inventory from 68 to 52 spaces.
- Incidental changes to building colors/painting.
- Net increase of up to 239 high school students above the currently approved facility capacity.
