Project Location: The Iron Horse Village project area (APNs: 213-020-037 and 213-020-046) is located at 3401 Crow Canyon Road, San Ramon, CA, 94583, Contra Costa County, which is an approximate 9.5 acres of the approximate 295-acre North Camino Ramon Specific Plan area.

Project Description: An Applicant-initiated proposed development plan and vesting tentative map to subdivide an existing 9.5-acre subject project area, demolish two existing office buildings (approx. 212,000 sq. ft.) and associated parking lots/landscape, construct a mixed use project with a residential component to include 117 residential dwelling units and various common area spaces. The site plan includes 86 detached single-family condominium homes and 31 attached multi-family condominium townhomes. The Project also includes a non-residential component consisting of 8 live-work units.

The project scope was previously analyzed by the North Camino Ramon Specific Plan Environmental Impact Report (EIR) (July 2012).
