Project Location: The project will occur within unnamed tributary to Meadow Creek at 1005 North Oak Park Boulevard in the City of Pismo Beach, San Luis Obispo County, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 079-261-012; Latitude 35.138732° North, Longitude -120.60793° West.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SLO-37440-R4, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Coastal Christian School.
