**Project Title:** Oak Tree Lane Road Widening and Extension Project (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2016-0130-R2), Major Amendment

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed an amendment to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2016-0130-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Lincoln.

The project is limited to the extension of the existing culvert, placement of a new culvert, installation of two utility pipes (for water and sewer), widening of the road (Oak Tree Lane), and removal of riparian vegetation. The existing Agreement is being amended to allow for the purchase of riparian credits from a mitigation bank instead of replanting onsite.
