Project Title: Modifications to the Cadiz Valley Water Conservation, Recovery and Storage Project

Project Applicant: Fenner Valley Water Authority, Santa Margarita Water District, Cadiz, Inc., Fenner Valley Mutual Water Company

Project Description: On July 31, 2012, the Santa Margarita Water District certified an Environmental Impact Report ("EIR") for the Cadiz Valley Water Conservation, Recovery and Storage Project ("Project"). The Project is designed to actively manage the groundwater basin underlying a portion of the Cadiz and Fenner Valleys located in the eastern Mojave Desert portion of San Bernardino County, California. The Project includes construction of an array of groundwater extraction wells and pumps, a wellfield manifold piping system, a 43-mile water conveyance pipeline, monitoring features, other appurtenances and fire suppression mechanisms. The conveyance pipeline would be constructed along the Arizona & California Railroad Company right-of-way and tie into the Colorado River Aqueduct.


Pursuant to a Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement, the Fenner Valley Water Authority is empowered to take all acts as are necessary and appropriate to carry out the Project Objectives. Santa Margarita Water District is a participant in the Project, a public private partnership, and is the managing member of the Fenner Valley Water Authority. The Fenner Valley Mutual Water Company is a California mutual water company formed for the purpose of operating the Project. Cadiz, Inc. will develop, finance and construct the Project.

Since approving and certifying the Final EIR in 2012 for the Project, the Project pipeline alignment has been redesigned slightly to add approximately 2 miles of pipeline to the 43-mile original alignment evaluated in the certified EIR. The modified alignment would connect the wellfield manifold system with the railroad right-of-way alignment at a different location than originally identified and a new 30-foot wide access road approximately 2 miles in length would be established for future maintenance along the modified alignment. In addition, a groundwater treatment facilities is proposed, consisting of a water treatment plant, storage, and booster pumping station.

An Addendum to the previously certified EIR was prepared to evaluate the potential for any new significant impacts, or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant impacts, to occur. The Addendum determined that neither the Project modifications, nor any changes in circumstances surrounding the Project, result in any new significant impact, or substantially increase the severity of an impact identified in the 2012 EIR. The Addendum further determined

that no new mitigation is required beyond the existing commitments contained within the 2012 EIR.
