**PROJECT TITLE:** La Jolla Improvements 2

**DESCRIPTION OF PREVIOUS ACTION:** The City of San Diego previously prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Citywide Pipeline project (Project No. 255100). The Mitigated Negative Declaration was certified by the City of San Diego City Council on November 30, 2011, Resolution No. 30712.

**DESCRIPTION OF SUBSEQUENT ACTION:** City of San Diego Development Services Department approval of Addendum to Mitigated Negative Declaration No. 255100 in association with a Public Project Assessment for the La Jolla Improvement 2 project.

**PROJECT LOCATION:** The project is located within the La Jolla Community Planning Area (Council District 1) within the following rights-of-way: Caminito Bello, Cliffridge Avenue, Dunaway Drive, Glenbrook Way, La Jolla Scenic Drive North, Nottingham Place, Robin Hood Lane, Scenic Place, Torrey Pines Road, and Via Posada. All work will be located within the City's rights-of-way and Torrey Pines Elementary School (APN: 346-711-06-00).

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The scope of work includes both water and sewer improvements. The water component of the project would replace approximately 9,354 linear feet (LF) (1.77 miles) of existing 8-, 12- and 16-inch diameter asbestos cement (AC) water mains by open trench method within the same trench alignment at greater depth with 8-, 12-, and 16-inch diameter polyvinyl chloride (PVC) water mains; install approximately 7,301 LF (1.38 miles) of new 8-, 12-, and 16-inch diameter PVC water mains in new trench alignments by open trench method at depths ranging from 4 to 6 feet; and abandon approximately 4,219 LF (0.80 mile) of AC water main. The sewer component of the project would replace approximately 4,096 LF (0.78 mile) of existing 4- and 8-inch diameter cast-iron (CI) and vitrified clay (VC) sewer mains by open trench method within the same trench alignment at a greater depth with 8-inch diameter PVC sewer mains; install approximately 2,484 LF (0.47 mile) of new 8-inch diameter PVC sewer mains in new alignments by open trench at depths ranging from 8 to 15 feet; and abandon approximately 2,289 LF (0.43 mile) of existing 8-inch diameter sewer mains. The project also includes curb ramps, street slurry seal, street resurfacing and traffic control plans.
