This supplemental MND evaluates proposed changes in the construction methods that are needed for Phase 3 repairs to the SCPL. Approximately 2,000 feet of twin 36-inch High-Density Polyethylene pipeline (HDPE) pipelines will be installed under Walnut Creek between Site 5 (Marathon) and Site 4 (Conco) utilizing horizontal directional drilling (HDD) construction methods. The twin 36-inch HDPE pipelines will be 60 to 80 feet below the ground surface to ensure that the new pipelines are in a layer of subsurface soil conditions that are more stable in the event of a potential seismic event.
