Title: Bon Air Road Bridge Replacement Project

Proponent: City of Larkspur Public Works Department

Location: City of Larkspur, Marin County.

Description: The City of Larkspur proposes to replace an existing floating dock and gangway that was included in the Bon Air Road Bridge Replacement Project. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through December 5, 2039.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, has approved the above described project on December 6, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, the City of Larkspur (City) adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Mitigation Monitoring Program and approved the project on August 1, 2012. An Addendum was approved on October 8, 2014. The California State Lands Commission has considered the MND and Addendum as prepared for this project by the City.
