The Project extends along Ranchero Road from approximately 2,200 feet east of Mariposa Road on the west to the Seventh Avenue on the east. The Ranchero Road Project Area is located at the southern side of Hesperia and adjacent to unincorporated San Bernardino County land. Project Description: This proposed project involves the widening Ranchero Road from its current two-lane and fourlane configuration to a five-lane facility within the City of Hesperia and its Sphere of Influence. The Project will result in impacts to 0.65 acres of western Joshua tree (Yucca brevifolia) habitat. The project is expected to result in incidental take of western Joshua tree, which is designated as a candidate threatened species under the California Endangered Species Act.
