## State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water California Environmental Quality Act Determination for Issuance of a Water Supply Permit

The Applicant is the Lead Agency under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The Applicant prepared an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND; SCH No. 2012101011) and a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan (MMRP) for the Project. The Applicant adopted the MND and MMRP and approved the Project on March 28, 2017. The State Water Board, Division of Drinking Water (DDW) is a Responsible Agency under CEQA for issuance of a water supply permit for the Project. The State Water Board, Division of Financial Assistance (DFA) is funding the Project, and the staff has reviewed the environmental documents listed herein and recommends the following determinations:

- 1. The Project will not result in any significant adverse water resources impacts.
- 2. The Project includes mitigation measures for air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, greenhouse gas emissions, hazardous waste, hydrology, water quality, noise, transportation, and traffic that mitigate potential environmental impacts to less than significant levels for these impact categories. Changes or alterations to the Project based on these mitigation measures are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of other public agencies and are not within the jurisdiction of the State Water Board. Such changes either have been adopted by other relevant agencies or can and should be adopted by such other agencies.

The DDW concurs with the DFA staff's recommended CEQA determinations.
