Project Location: The project is located at Whitehouse Creek and associated tributaries northwest of the intersection of Bond Road and Waterman Road in the City of Elk Grove, in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.427507, Longitude -121.357358 within Section 30, Township 7N, Range 9E, in U.S. Geological Survey map Elk Grove. Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0047-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Elliott Homes, as represented by Price Walker.

The project includes the development of the 230-acre property for mixed uses including approximately 660 residential units on 115 acres, an age restricted multi-family lodge on 4.6 acres, 81 acres of open space and wetland preserve, 5.5 acres of parks, 3.4 acres of landscaping, 14.8 acres of detention pond, and 5.5 acres of roads.
