**Project Title:** Silverwood (Tapestry Phase I) Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, Environmental Permit Information Management System (EPIMS) Notification No. SBR-18339-R6)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located east of Interstate 15 and north of State Route 173 within the City of Hesperia, San Bernardino County, approximately 8 miles east of I-15, north of SR-173, south of Ranchero Road, and west of Arrowhead Lake Road miles at approximately Latitude 34.367085°, Longitude - 117.281207°. The Project site is bounded by City of Hesperia development to the north, the Mojave River to the east, the West Fork Mojave River to the south, and the California Aqueduct to the west.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement, EPIMS Notification No. SBR-18339-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Silverwood Development Phase 1, LLC.

The project is limited to development of Phase 1 of the Tapestry Specific Plan. Project activities covered under this Streambed Alteration Agreement include: grading and filing of steams for construction of residential pads and parks, internal roadways, trails, stormwater system infrastructure, and other facilities; geotechnical exploration within streams; installation a bridge and associated construction activities for a road crossing of a stream; installation of a bottomless arch culverts and associated construction activities in three locations for road crossings of streams; and installation of a reinforced concrete box culvert and associated construction activities in two locations for road crossings of streams.
