The District proposes to implement the Wet Weather Equalization Expansion Project (proposed project), which would modify the multi-purpose wet-weather equalization facility constructed as part of a previous project described and evaluated in the Wet Weather Equalization and Ecotone Demonstration Project Initial Study Mitigated Negative Declaration (ISMND; SCH 2013112070). The proposed project would deepen the existing wet-weather equalization basin to increase equalization capacity from 8 to 24 million gallons. The proposed project site consists of a 4.5-acre parcel located at 2536 Grant Avenue in the community of San Lorenzo, unincorporated Alameda County, California, adjacent to and east of the existing OLSO wastewater treatment plant.
