Project Location: The project includes the vacation of existing roadways within the Port of Los Angeles. The affected areas include: Fries Avenue between "A" Street and Water Street at the Union Pacific railroad tracks, Avalon Boulevard between Harry Bridges Boulevard and Water Street at the Union Pacific railroad tracks, and "A" Street between Avalon Boulevard and the driveway located to immediately west of Avalon Boulevard.

Brief Project Description: The Project involves the closure of Avalon Boulevard, Fries Avenue, and "A" Street Roadway Segments in the Port of Los Angeles and associated construction activities. Initially, the roadway segments will be closed using fencing and k-rails (i.e., modular concrete or plastic barriers) followed by permanent closure through physical street modifications including the installation of cul-de-sacs, curbs and gutters, driveways, sidewalks, and signage. The street closures are necessary to comply with California Public Utilities Commission General Order 135, which limits road-crossing blockages due to stopped or switching train cars to 10 minutes

Determination: Based on a review of the project as proposed, the Department of Fish and Wildlife has determined that for purposes of the assessment of CEQA filing fees (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (c)) the project has no effect on fish, wildlife or their habitat and the project as described does not require payment of a CEQA filing fee.
