Project Title: Aidlin Hills Development (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2015-0271-R5)

Project Location (Los Angeles County): The Project is located in the City of Santa Clarita, Los Angeles County, California. The Project is located in the northern foothills of the Santa Susana Mountains alongside Pico Canyon Road at Assessor's Parcel Numbers 2826-020-020 through 024, 2826-020-030 through 033, and 2826-097-033.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (Notification No. 1600-2015-0271-R5), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, LENNAR as represented by Brian Bencz.

The project is limited to the construction of 102 single-family dwelllings and associated infrastructure, which includes roadways, two 250,000-gallon water tanks with pump station, water quality treatment basins, and an emergency fire access road. In addition to this development, a 2.6-acre restoration project will be completed in Marple Canyon to restore riparian habitat.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on August 17, 2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
