DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Complete improvements at the Wilson-McConnell Residence in Columbia State Historic Park, to allow for installation of an accessible ramp on the southern side of the residence to provide access for park visitors with mobility issues. This work is an amendment to the Wilson-McConnell Residence project (SCH# 2014108441) to add additional ADA considerations. Work will:

- Remove some landscape shrubs and a small existing woodshed to prepare space for accessibility ramp installation;
- Use #1 grade or better redwood decking, posts, guardrails, and top rail, and painted steel pipe handrails to construct an ADA ramp that maintains a maximum 1:12 slope with a 5' diameter clearance for turning radius on the top and bottom of the ramp; and;
- Install ISA wayfinding signs at the main (west) porch, accessible ramp entry, and existing compliant restroom structure.
