Project Location (include county): The project is located at the Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal at 1800 Crosby Road, in the City of San Diego.

Project Description: The project includes a variety of infrastructure investments that may be undertaken over the long term to accommodate an increase of the Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal's capabilities and capacity. The Redevelopment Plan includes the Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal Beyond Compliance Environmental Enhancement Project, which will deploy and operate an Advanced Marine Emission Control System. This technology will connect to a vessel's exhaust stack and capture the vessel's particulate emissions while at berth, allowing the Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal to handle more cargo while limiting the associated impacts to the adjacent community.
