Project Title: Sibannac, LLC Pond-Spillway and Stream Crossing Maintenance (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2017-0080-R1)

Project Location (include county): The project site is located at 1500 Hyampom Road, approximately 1.5 miles west of the town of Hayfork in Trinity County, California within the Hayfork Creek watershed. The stream crossing and spillway maintenance projects are located an unnamed ephemeral stream and an unnamed perennial tributary to Hayfork Creek; Section 10, Township 31N, Range 12W; U.S. Geological Survey Hayfork 7.5 Minute Quad Map, Mt. Diablo Meridian.

Project Description: The projects as covered under the scope of the Streambed Alteration Agreement are limited to the upgrading of two existing ford crossings to meet 100-year flow criteria as well as maintenance and in-stream stabilization activities associated with the spillway and downstream section of existing reservoir in order to minimize sedimentation in the watershed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project on April 25, 2019 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21081, subdivision (a).
