**Project Title:** Deferred Maintenance Replacement of Culvert Sites 545 and 549 (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. YOL-45628-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located on the right bank of Willow Slough Bypass, in the County of Yolo, State of California; Site 545 is located at Levee Mile 4.29; 38.58953, -121.68056; Site 549 is located at Levee Mile 5.40; 38.58954, -121.66007.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number YOL-45628-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the California Department of Water Resources.

The project is limited to the excavation of two existing 24-inch diameter dilapidated metal culverts at Site 545 and Site 549, and the installation of two precast 24-inch diameter reinforced concrete culverts, outfall structures, inlets, and headwalls. Each culvert outlet will be extended and backfilled to meet the existing banks of Willow Slough Bypass.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
