Project Title: Alta Mesa Road over Laguna Creek Bridge Replacement (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0055-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at Laguna Creek, approximately 2 miles northeast of the community of Herald in unincorporated Sacramento County, State of California; Latitude 38.310872 Longitude -121.226394, Section 4/5, Township 5N, Range 7E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Clay, approximately 0.4 miles north of Twin Cities Road within County Right-of-Way.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0055-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Sacramento County Department of Transportation, as represented by Tim Stevens

The project includes bridge and roadway improvements on Alta Mesa Road. The scope of work will include removing and replacing the existing bridge structures crossing Laguna Creek and modernizing the roadway approaches.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on Month/Day/Year and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
